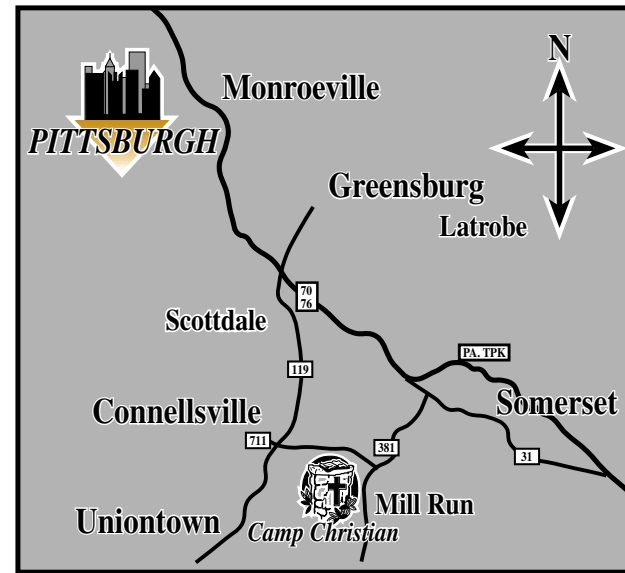

HOW TO GET TO CAMP



-- From CONNELLSVILLE, follow Rt. 711 North to Normalville. At Normalville, continue straight ahead onto Rt. 381 South for two miles; turn right at the “Camp Christian” sign just beyond the iron bridge.

-- From SOMERSET, follow Rt. 31 toward Donegal. Turn left on Rt. 711 / follow to Normalville. Turn left onto Rt. 381 South & continue as instructed above.

--From the PA TURNPIKE, the Donegal Interchange is nearest to the camp. Turn left on Rt. 31, follow three miles, turn right onto Rt. 711. Follow to Normalville; turn left onto Rt. 381 South and continue as instructed above.

For four days and three nights, our campers will be doing just what every other ordinary kid does at summer camp – and that’s the most extraordinary thing of all.

Campers who attend ROCK week will have been or are being treated for cancer. When you are young, cancer often means not being able to do everything your friends are doing. Cancer can make a child feel “different,” and that can be the worst side effect of all. This summer Camp Christian, (a non-profit Christian/Church of Christ organized and sponsored camping facility) located just 65 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, PA, will be conducting a special week of camp called “ROCK” Week. ROCK stands for “Reaching Out to Cancer Kids.” Campers can swim and relax under the warm summer sun... explore their creativity with arts and craft projects...all in a safe environment.



The camp’s setting provides the perfect backdrop for enjoying outdoor activities and developing lasting friendships...for exploring nature and learning about a special kind of sharing, caring and being loved.
